Utility Ratemaking for Boards & Councils 4 Hours

Electric costs around the country are rising due to changes in power supply costs, aging infrastructures, significant capital improvements, and pressure to increase city contributions. To help ensure customer rates are structured correctly It is important for management and Boards to understand the utility's cost structure and use the information to send price signals to customers.
